II. **The Structure of the abstract:** research objectives, research methods and procedures, subjects, tests etc., results, discussions and conclusions, (brief description), key words (3 to 5 key words which are descriptive of the paper's content and areas). Times New Roman, Size 10, Justify;

#### III. The Body of the paper

**Introduction and research objective** (Times New Roman, Size 10, Justify, two columns);

**Research methods and procedures** (subjects, tests description etc.), **results, discussions.**

**Conclusions, references** (Times New Roman, Size 10, Justify, two columns)

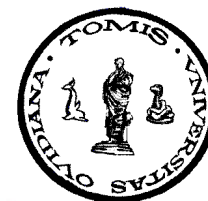
